Additional responsibilities include oversight of the archiving and preservation of thousands of artifacts which have been entrusted to the Town by generations of Wytheville and Wythe County families, an extensive research library, educational outreach programs that providing learning opportunities for thousands of children each year, and a variety of special events which showcase the relevance of history and heritage in today's world.
